

Onboard Took Kit

As all boat owners know, owning a boat is a great justification for having a decent tool kit.

Most Engines are now metric, however older engines can still use imperial sizes. Make sure you know what is used on your boat to make sure you have the right size spanners.

Spanner Set – socket size up to ~20mm
Adjustable Spanner
Pliers – including wire cutting and crimping function
Flat bladed Screw Drivers
Phillips Screwdrivers
Precision Screwdriver kit. - great for small fiddly components or fixing electrical components.
Sharp Knife
Syphoning hose – garden hose works very well
Magnet on extendable handle
Feeler Gauges
Hex Key or Allen Keys – metric
Multimeter – a basic \$10 option from the auto shop will be fine
Hygrometer
Spanners – I would just carry the common ones. 7mm, 10mm, 13mm, 15mm and will cover most cases.
Pipe Cleaners – don't laugh – these are usefull.
Insulated Screwdriver
Mutligrips
Vice Grips
Hammer or soft Mallet
Scraping device
20mm Paint brush
